亀 The Tortoise And The Crane 鶴-auspicious congratulatory event-

Each player finds one or more *traditional* instrument(s) or object(s) that create sound. (whatever in any sense is *traditional*. It can be conventionally traditional or provocatively alternative) Divide performers equally into two groups - *crane* or *tortoise*.

- Each performer chooses a text from Jo section. (*crane* group selects from crane segments and tortoise from tortoise's)
- 2 Crane and tortoise form a line, facing each other and make a partner with whoever is in front.
- After 5-10 seconds (approx.) of silence, players at the left end of each line start Jo together.

 Sound can be a tone, a hit, sustained or repeated. It should represent own idea for the chosen text.
- Two players end sounds collectively and the next two on the right start after a few seconds of pause. It continues till everyone in the line plays. If the number of players is odd, the last person plays alone.
- Each performer chooses a text from Ha section.(*crane* group selects from crane segments and *tortoise* from tortoise's)

 Repeat 3 4 with Ha.
- Each performer chooses a text from Kyu section.(*crane* group selects from crane segments and *tortoise* from tortoise's)

 Repeat 3 4 with Kyu.
- 7 The last player ends smoothly and peacefully
